2448	Exodus from Egypt on the 15 <sup>th</sup> of Nissan. The Jewish people witnessed the miraculous Splitting of the Sea on the 21 <sup>st</sup> of Nissan. Moses led the men in songs, Miriam led the women in song and dance with instruments.	-1313
2448	Revelation of Sinai on the 6 <sup>th</sup> of Sivan.	
2487	Aaron and Miriam died. Miriam passed away at the age of 126 on the 10 <sup>th</sup> of Nissan, 39 years after the Exodus and one year before the Jewish people entered the Holy Land. Aaron passed away on Rosh Chodesh Av.	-1273
2488	Moses died on the 7 <sup>th</sup> of Adar.	-1273
2488	The Jewish people crossed the Jordan River, entering the Land of Israel on the $10^{\mathrm{th}}$ of Nissan.	-1273
